Registration has begun for Kindergarten 2018-2019. If you, or someone you know, have a child born in 2013, it is time to register them for Kindergarten.

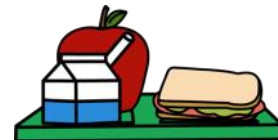

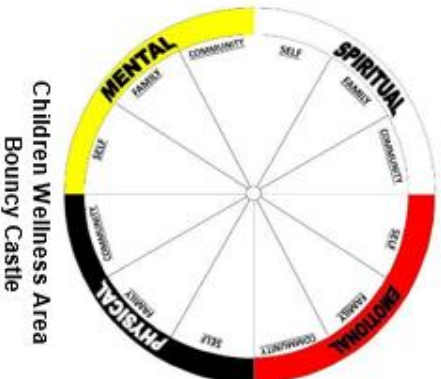
